
Excellent start for graduates Erasmus University Rotterdam

Finds a job right away

Thinks the program offers a (very) good basis

96% of the graduates are part of employed labor force within a year and a half after graduation, with a paid job of more than 12 hours a week (nationwide: 94%).

49% of graduates find a job immediately after graduation (national: 41%) On average there are 2.2 months between graduation and the first paid job (national: 2.7).

61% of the graduates think that the program provides (very) a strong basis for starting on the labor market (nationwide: 52%).
