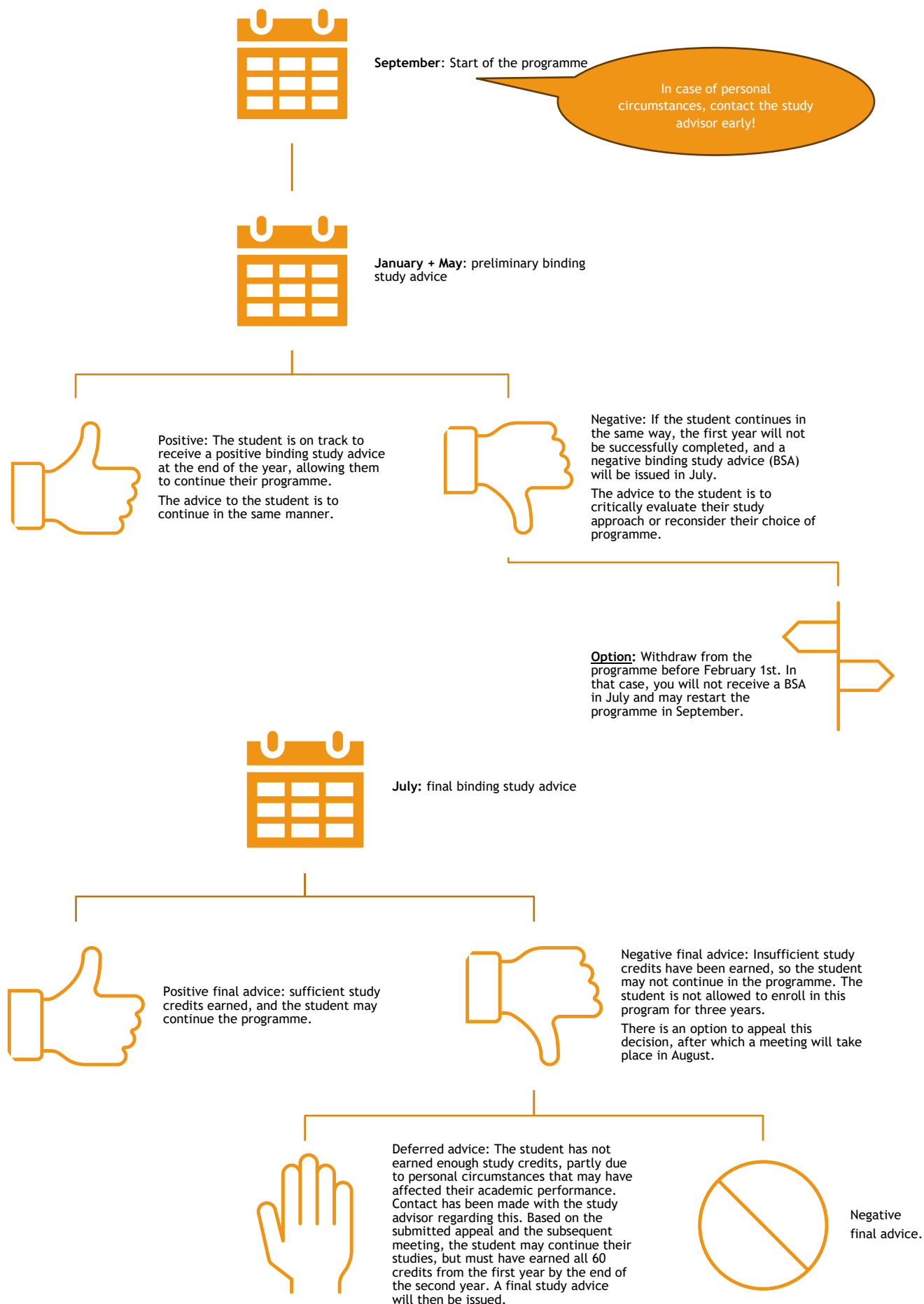


## BINDING STUDY ADVICE

Each academic year, you can earn a maximum of 60 credits. In the first year of your programme, you will receive a binding study advice (BSA) based on the number of credits you have obtained. The BSA standard may differ per programme. At ESSB, you must obtain all 60 credits to meet the BSA requirements\*.



\* To receive a positive BSA, according [article 7.4 in the Education and Examination Regulations \(EER\)](#), you must meet the following requirements:

**Psychology:**

- > The student has obtained an average grade of 6.0 for all courses, with a maximum of two final grades between 5.0 up until and including 5.4, and no final grades below 5.0; and
- > has completed test subject hours

**Pedagogical Sciences:**

- > The student has completed each component with a minimal final grade of 5.5.

**Public Administration, MISOC, and Sociology:**

- > The student must have obtained a minimum average final grade of 6.0 for all courses, with a maximum of two final grades between 5.0 up until and including 5.4, and no final grades below 5.0.

Note! Partial grades must be at least a 4.5 to receive a valid final grade (see [article 15 in the Rules and Regulations](#)).
